













# HD DELUXE™ - FOOTSTOOL

Our **HD DELUXE™ – Footstool** is designed to provide extra height in so many different ways – placed on the floor under feet, on a bed under legs, on a bed to give extra push up capability and many many more. It can even be used to adminster personal care. See below for different ways to use our **HD DELUXE™ – Footstool**.

# **USER INSTRUCTIONS**



Place the **HD Deluxe™ – Footstool** at the side of your bed. This can then be used as a step to get in or out of bed more easily if your feet can't touch the floor or if your bed doesn't go low enough.



Place one HD Deluxe™ –
Footstool next to the user at the edge of the mattress. The user can use the stool to push off to help with a sitting or standing movement. Using two HD Deluxe™ – Footstools, one on either side can also help.











Stand the HD Deluxe™ – Footstool on its side, then place the user's heel, ankle or calf inside an arch. This helps with offloading weight from the ankle or can even be used to help with personal hygiene and daily dressing.



When in a side-lying position place the HD Deluxe™ – Footstool in between both knees so each knee fits inside a curve of the stool. This additional support will reduce pressure points and provide access for personal hygiene.



Place the **HD Deluxe™ – Footstool** on the floor near the users knee. Lift one knee and rest it on the stool. With one knee now raised slightly higher this will help with standing up from the floor.



Position the HD Deluxe™ – Footstool around the basin of the toilet as shown in the picture above. Place both feet on the footstool and sit down on the toilet. By having the feet slightly raised, this helps with toileting as it opens the bowel.

#### STORAGE AND HANDLING


## FUNCTIONAL INDEPENDENCE MEASURE (FIM) ASSESSMENT

Our FIM assessment guide for each product will help you decide the suitability of this product for the person's ability and need. Based on the standard criteria from Level 6 where the person can use the product unaided and unsupervised to Level 1 where all the assistance is provided by the carer and the client can do nothing, this guide is easy, quick and simple to use to check suitability against ability and circumstance.

## **EASY GUIDE SYMBOLS**

We use four symbols to indicate where a product is suitable and safe for the person to use unassisted, with a single carer or with multiple carers. These symbols indicate the minimum recommendation.
