



HD DELUXE™ LIMB PAD – ANGULAR POSITIONING WEDGE

This guide covers the product code with the product code LIMWEDG01.

Our **HD Deluxe™ Limb Pad – Angular Positioning Wedge** can help provide pressure relief and extra comfort in many different lying positions; as a support for arms, legs, or in combination with other limb pads from our range depending in your needs. Below are some examples of how it can be used.

USER INSTRUCTIONS



Place the **Limb Pad – Angular** as shown under the users arm when side lying. This will help them maintain a natural posture and provide support for the shoulder in this position.

Using the limb pad in this way can also provide security and reassurance for users with dementia.



Position the **Limb Pad – Angular** under a raised leg so it slopes down to the edge of the bed mattress. This allows the limb to be raised in stages (higher or lower) for sleeping posture, physio or greater access for personal care.





In conjunction with the Limb Pad – Rectangle. The Limb Pad – Angular can be used to offer extra support when the user is side lying, either with the limb pad facing inwards as shown or outward like section 1 illustrates.



Limb Pad – Angular can be used in a variety of configurations. One of which is to form a raised knee-brake elevation to stop slippage down the bed. This can be achieved be placing 2 limb pads side by side under the knee joint before raising the head section of the bed.



The Limb Pad – Angular and the Limb Pad – Rectangle are the same height so they can be used together. Place the Limb Pad – Angular under the thighs and the Limb Pad – Rectangle under the patient's calfs so the ankles are raised. The head section of the bed can then be profiled. Together they will form a knee-break and stop the patient moving down the bed.



For maximum patient comfort and support add the thinner Limb Pad – Folding under the elbow joint to reduce the pressure points down the shoulder and forearm. Two Limb Pad – Angular can also be used with the Limb Pad – Rectangle to elevate the legs and support the ankles.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

- Store in a clean dry environment that is not subject to excessive heat.

Based on the standard criteria from Level 6 where the score respectively. the person can use the product unaided and unsupervised to Level 1 where all the assistance is provided by the carer and the client can do nothing, this guide is easy, guick and simple to use to check suitability against ability and circumstance.

EASY GUIDE SYMBOLS

We use four symbols to indicate where a product is suitable and safe for the person to use unassisted, with a single carer or with multiple carers. These symbols indicate the minimum recommendation.
