The **Hip Assist Pack** combines a series of essential aids for those who are waiting for or recovering from hip replacements.

HIP ASSIST PACK **EXPLAINED**

GLIDE CUSHION



The **Glide Cushion** is ultra-soft with a quilted slippery material on the inside and comfortable polycotton on the top. For those who struggle to roll from side to side in bed the cushion can offer a fantastic low friction solution allowing users to turn easily throughout the night with zero assistance.

CAR SLIDE SHEET



The **Car Slide Sheet** is a slide sheet designed to help swivel in and out of a car with ease. For those waiting for a hip operation it can greatly ease the difficulties of getting in and out of a car and it can be used independently or with the help of a carer.

Please note: it must be removed prior to the car moving – see instructions.

ANTI-SLIP SLIDE SHEET



This Anti-Slip Slide Sheet helps patients rotate and re-position themselves easily in bed. It prevents patients from sliding forward or slipping out of bed whilst the double slide sheet panel offers easy bed repositioning. If you are waiting for a hip replacement then this sheet can make getting in and out of bed so much easier.

WEBBING ROPE LADDER



This easy to attach bed ladder allows patients to maintain in control as they sit forward or lie down. Patients who would otherwise struggle to manoeuvre themselves can further improve their independence and rehabilitation with the **Webbing Rope Ladder**.

HANDYBAR®



Created as an aid to sit or stand from a vehicle, the **Handybar®** offers extra assistance and leverage to get in and out of a vehicle unaided. The Handybar simply drops into the steel U shaped door lock on the side of the vehicle.

USER INSTRUCTIONS GLIDE CUSHION







Unfold the **Glide Cushion** and place on the bed so that the open edges are across the bed and the product is near to the pillows.

Make sure the soft quilted side is on the outside and the slippy finish is on the inside.

The main trunk of your body (shoulders to hips) can now lie on the cushion, turn with ease into a new position and sleep on the **Glide Cushion** throughout the night.

CAR SLIDE SHEET

Place the **Car Slide Sheet** on the seat to be used by the person requiring some assistance. This can be done by either the person themselves or with a carer/helper.

This can be used both on the driver or passenger sides but **MUST BE REMOVED PRIOR TO THE CAR MOVING**.

With the open sides running parallel to the seat, tuck the **Car Slide Sheet** between the back rest and the seat where it will be secured.

The user can then lower themselves onto the seat. They may support themself by holding onto any part of the car.

They can then gently swivel around so they are facing front.



REMOVING THE CAR SLIDE SEAT

Leaning in towards the middle of the car, the **Car Slide Sheet** can simply be pulled gently out from underneath the user's bottom.

The **Car Slide Sheet** can be folded up and placed in the door pocket ready to be used to get out at the end of the journey.

GETTING INTO OF BED

Place the **Anti Slip Slide Sheet** along the edge of the mattress by the pillow so the anti slip strip is near the edge.

Now sit on the **Anti Slip Slide Sheet** with both feet on the floor. The anti slip strip will prevent any slippage off the edge of the mattress. Place the palms of your hands on the anti-slip material on either side of you and wriggle back on the slide sheet material until you are more central in the bed

You can then safely raise your legs independently or if you need some help use our **Leg Lifter** (sold separately), to help get your legs into bed.

Turn both legs or one at a time onto the mattress and slide into the middle of the bed. Use the ladder to help lie you flat if required and remove.

HANDYBAR®







Insert the **Handybar®** into the U-shaped socket on the door lock while using the car door as additional support, as shown to stand forward.

Once in an upright position make sure that you are stable before removing the **Handybar®** and store it back in the door pocket of your vehicle.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

EASY GUIDE SYMBOLS

We use four symbols to indicate where a product is suitable and safe for the person to use unassisted, with a single carer or with multiple carers. These symbols indicate the minimum recommendation.
